With this third and final newsletter, the SOLAR team would like to share the results achieved and thank all those who have accompanied the project throughout its three-year journey, which began in December 2022 and will conclude on November 29, 2025.

SOLAR was created with the aim of promoting adult education on solar energy and environmental sustainability, offering innovative, free, and multilingual tools. The project sought to make knowledge about renewable energies accessible to everyone, supporting educators and adult learners in understanding the value of the sun as a clean and renewable energy source.

## MAIN RESULTS

Thanks to the collaboration of the partners Giva srl (Italy), Rosso Arancio (Italy), SFB ltd (Bulgaria), and Tecomsa Telecommunication ltd (Cyprus), the project has developed and made available four main products, all freely downloadable and usable:

- SOLAR Toolkit for adult educators – a practical and comprehensive guide, full of activities, lesson plans, and ready-to-use materials for training contexts.
- SOLAR European Web Resource Centre – an online platform where you can freely access materials, podcasts, and the e-learning course.
- SOLAR e-learning course – an interactive and multilingual path offering clear content, quizzes, and final certification, designed for adult learners.
- “Energy Quest” board game – a fun way to learn how to manage energy and reflect on sustainable choices in daily life.

## TRAINING ACTIVITIES

During the project, about thirty people were trained among educators and adult trainers, who in turn contributed to spreading the materials in their respective educational contexts. Thanks to the multiplier events organized in the partner countries – Italy, Bulgaria, and Cyprus – hundreds of people were able to discover and test the tools developed by SOLAR, thus helping to promote a more aware energy culture.

## A PROJECT THAT CONTINUES TO LIVE

Although the project will officially end on November 29, 2025, all materials will remain freely accessible online, available to educators, learners, and interested

citizens. The consortium believes that, thanks to the quality of the results and the dissemination activities carried out, SOLAR will continue to sustain and grow independently, spreading good practices of sustainability and lifelong learning throughout Europe and beyond.
